

Spring Term Attendance Challenge 2018

Our first attendance challenge of the year ran for 5 weeks from Christmas until February half term.

The whole school average during the challenge was 95.7%.

A very impressive 254 children attended school every day during the challenge period and had no late marks. These children were rewarded with a certificate and a small prize.

We will be organising a second attendance challenge later on in the year and hope to reward even more children with certificates and prizes.
