

Dear Parent,

As the weather is becoming increasingly cold and miserable we would like to try to reduce the amount of time the children are waiting outside at the end of the school day. Therefore, we have made some small changes to the arrangements for collecting children after school.

Overleaf is a map of the school playground that has been split into three areas for parents to collect children from each year group. Please stand in the given area for you child and once you have been seen by the class teacher, your child will be released to you.

Year 2 and year 3 will be dismissed from their classrooms at 2.50 p.m.

Year 4 will be dismissed from their classroom at 2.55 p.m.

Year 5 will walk through the double doors onto the playground at 2.55 p.m.

Year 6 will be dismissed through the double doors onto the playground at 3.00p.m.

Please do not arrive in school the grounds before the time your child/ren is due to leave school, this will hopefully ease the congestion within school and will reduce the time that parents are waiting for children in the cold.

As a school community, we really hope that our families will be able to enjoy Christmas with their loved ones. Please can we ask that you follow these few steps within school to help reduce the spread:

- Adults wear face coverings on school property
- As far as possible keep socially distanced on the playground.
- Where there is congestion around the exits, please wait for a space.
- Children to stay with their grown up on the playground so that people are stood within their family group.

We know that there are still a number of cases with the Armthorpe community. To help reduce the spread please ensure that you follow the government guidance. If someone in your household displays symptoms of the virus, all members of the household are asked to isolate until that person has had a test and has their result. If they test positive, all members of the household must stay at home for two weeks from when the symptoms began.
